



## Conclusion

### **Text: Philippians 4:15-20**

<sup>15</sup> You yourselves also know, Philippians, that at the first *preaching* of the gospel, after I left Macedonia, no church shared with me in the matter of giving and receiving except you alone; <sup>16</sup> for even in Thessalonica you sent a *gift* more than once for my needs. <sup>17</sup> Not that I seek the gift *itself*, but I seek the profit which increases to your account. <sup>18</sup> But I have received everything in full and have an abundance; I am amply supplied, having received from Epaphroditus what you have sent, a fragrant aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, pleasing to God. <sup>19</sup> And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus. <sup>20</sup> Now to our God and Father *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.

### **Related Texts:**

**3 John 5-8** <sup>5</sup> Beloved, you are acting faithfully in whatever you accomplish for the brothers *and sisters*, and especially *when they are* strangers; <sup>6</sup> and they have testified to your love before the church. You will do well to send them on their way in a manner worthy of God. <sup>7</sup> For they went out for the sake of the Name, accepting nothing from the Gentiles. <sup>8</sup> Therefore we ought to support such people, so that we may prove to be fellow workers with the truth.

### **Proverbs 11:25**

<sup>25</sup> A generous person will be prosperous, And one who gives *others* plenty of water will himself be given plenty.

**Luke 6:38** <sup>38</sup> Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure—pressed down, shaken together, *and* running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return.”

**2 Corinthians 9:6** <sup>6</sup> Now *I say* this: the one who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and the one who sows generously will also reap generously.

**Hebrews 13:15-16** <sup>15</sup> Through Him then, let's continually offer up a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips praising His name. <sup>16</sup> And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.

### **Proverbs 3:9-10**

<sup>9</sup> Honor the LORD from your wealth, And from the first of all your produce; <sup>10</sup> Then your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.

### **2 Corinthians 9:8-10**

<sup>8</sup> And God is able to make all grace overflow to you, so that, always having all sufficiency in everything, you may have an abundance for every good deed; <sup>9</sup> as it is written: "HE SCATTERED ABROAD, HE GAVE TO THE POOR, HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS ENDURES FOREVER." <sup>10</sup> Now He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness;

### **1 Corinthians 10:31**

<sup>31</sup> Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all things for the glory of God.
